



THE CENTRAL CALIFORNIA KOI SOCIETY'S 45th ANNUAL KOI SHOW September 26 – September 28, 2025

Our annual koi show will be held at the **Woodward Park – Group Activity Center, next to Shinzen Friendship Garden, located at 114 W. Audubon Dr., Fresno, CA 93720** with set up starting on Friday September 26th at 7:00 am and koi check in beginning at 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. *All koi not checked in by 6:00 pm on Friday September 26th will need to be in their tanks by 8:00 am on Saturday, September 27th to be entered into the koi show data base and be benched.*

Parking at Woodward Park information:

ENTRANCE FEES: Entrance fees into Fresno regional parks are \$5 per vehicle. Vehicles in which a senior citizen (age 65 or older) is a passenger/driver will be admitted for \$3 per vehicle. Entrance is free for vehicles displaying a disabled person placard/decal, vehicles in which a U.S. active-duty military member or family member with proper identification is a passenger or driver, or vehicles displaying a California state "Gold Star" license plate. Find a kiosk and print out a pre-paid parking ticket and display on vehicle dash.

On Saturday, September 27th, koi judging begins at 10:00 am and our show ends on Sunday, September 28th at 3:00 pm. All koi are to be in their tanks no later than 8:00 am Saturday, September 27th. Our show banquet will be on Saturday, September 27th beginning at 5:00 p.m., dinner will be served at 6:00 p.m., the banquet location: private club member's home, **location will be given at registration**; dinner will be via privately catered company, which will be at the cost of \$60.00 each which includes the meal ticket, and dessert, tickets must be purchased in advance, no tickets sold at the door, all banquet reservations due before September 1st, 2025.

This show is open to any koi hobbyist interested in showing at our event and all koi hobbyists are cordially invited. All koi entered must be owned by koi exhibitor, no dealer owned koi allowed. Space is limited so please register early as show tanks will be reserved on first come first serve basis. The show will have koi and pond vendors available selling pond equipment, koi food, and koi, as well as a silent auction, and table raffle.

Our show is always expanding and improving for both the koi hobbyist and public who come to enjoy viewing the beauties that travel from as far south as Temecula to as far north as Sacramento, California.

Entry:

1. This is an open show to all Koi Hobbyists and will be conducted English style, where entrants will be Assigned their own tank(s) for their fish only. Registered entrants must own all fish entered in the show. No dealer owned koi allowed.

2. **VERY IMPORTANT:** All entrants must be present at their show tank while koi are being measured and classified, as well as signing off of the benching form. No koi will be entered without exhibitor being present during benching. Please complete the Registration Form and submit before the deadline of September 1, 2025. Exhibitor's entry fee tank fees: \$75.00 for single tank, \$120.00 for 2 tanks, \$180.00 for 3 tanks. To allow for additional exhibitors, each entrant will be allowed a maximum of 3 tanks. Koi Show Banquet tickets are \$60.00 each held on 09/27/25, beginning at 5pm on location at private club member home, location will be given upon registration. Pick up map/ticket on Friday, September 26th at show site registration desk.

3. Make checks payable to **CCKS** and mail to **5832 E. Erin Ave., Fresno, CA 93727** as registrations forms are received, show tanks will be assigned accordingly, **no tanks will be reserved without payment received.** For those interested in paying with credit card/debit card, a Square invoice can be sent, just request via email at cencalkoi@gmail.com

4. All fish will be individually photographed upon arrival and be measured for size before being placed into the tanks. Fish will be sized and classified; accordingly, all benching decisions are final with the exception of any judge's changes.

5. Hotel Accommodations: Hotel Piccadilly Inn, 2305 W. Shaw Ave., Fresno, CA 93711.

A block of rooms has been reserved for a special show rate of \$99.00, plus tax Executive King Room-1King bed or \$106.00, plus tax Executive Double Room, 2 Queen Beds. Rate includes free breakfast for two and free parking.

Judging:

1. No members or fish owners will be allowed in the center aisle during the judging process. *Only Judges, Recorders, Assigned Photographer and fish handlers, who are benching fish, are allowed to be in the center aisle during judging.* Please stay on the outside of the yellow tape or you will be asked to move. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** Do not talk to the judges or point out your fish during the judging. The judges will be happy to answer questions, visit and talk to you after their work is done.
2. Injuries that leave permanent scars or deformities may count against the fish at the discretion of the Judges. Injuries not permanent in nature will be overlooked during judging.
3. The decisions of the judges and show committee are final.

Delivery and Removal of Fish:

1. For the health and safety of your fish, **DO NOT FEED YOUR FISH FOR 5 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SHOW.**
2. Fish are to be delivered on Friday, September 26th, 2025, between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. All fish must be in the tanks by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 27th, (the day of the show) to be ready for judging. That means registered, photographed, measured, classified and tank(s) assigned to all entrants. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Exhibitors will need to be present at their tank during benching and also sign off on the benching form or KOI will NOT be eligible for entering.
3. All fish must be in good health. Any fish deemed by the entry committee to be showing possible signs of any disease or parasites must be removed immediately.
4. At the close of the show, on Sunday, September 28th, 2025, CCKS will provide bags, rubber bands and oxygen to assist entrants with transporting fish safely home.
5. All fish must be picked up from 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 28th, 2025. Please try not to pickup your fish before 3:00 p.m. if you need to leave prior to 3pm please get permission from show chair in advance, priority will be given to those traveling further distances, contact Show Chair, Rosimeri Tran, at 559-970-8508 or via email at cencalkoi@gmail.com.
6. In the event there are unclaimed fish after the closing of the show; the fish will be held for (5) days, after which they become the property of CCKS.
7. All necessary and reasonable precautions will be taken by the Central California Koi Society to safeguard entered Koi. Therefore, all participating in the show will agree to hold CCKS, its officers, directors and general membership blameless against any loss or injury of the fish.
8. Past Champions - Once a koi (A & B) has been awarded Grand Champion at a CCKS show, the Grand Champion fish is not eligible to compete the following year but is eligible any year after that.
9. All Gin Rin koi will be given the option during benching to be entered in either the Gin Rin A (Gosanke - Kohaku, Showa and Sanke) category or Gin Rin B (non Gosanke) category.
10. *NEW in 2023: added B category to all Champion awards and Best in Size 1 – 9. Baby Champion awards size 1-2, Young Champion size 3-4, Adult Champion 5-6, Mature Champion size 7-9. All koi qualify for Grand Champion from any size group. Longfin measurement to include from the tip of the nose to the tip of the tail.*
